

Language requirements: B1 in French and /or English

It is highly recommended to have some knowledge of French language before arriving at UTT but students can choose only English-taught courses and do without any French as long as their English level is B1.

Internships

While they are attending their first semester of studies at UTT, any student can apply for an internship, either in one of UTT's 8 laboratories (see "Recherche" at utt.fr to find out about research fields), or at a French company in a field related to their studies. These internships are open to undergraduate and graduate students and last between 2 to 6 months.








Internship at a UTT laboratory:

- Get up to 30 ECTS credits
- Take part in the daily activities of a research team
- Spend time at one of France's top university laboratories
- Get personal supervision from a UTT professor
- Begin any time of the year.

Industrial internships:

- Get up to 30 ECTS credits
- Get support and advice from UTT's internships service
- Take part in the daily activities of a French company
- Earn a salary (minimum 600 € per month)
- Gain professional experience
- Begin any time of the year
